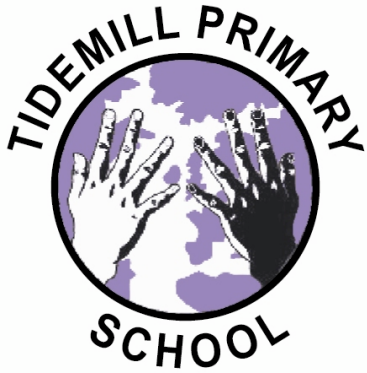

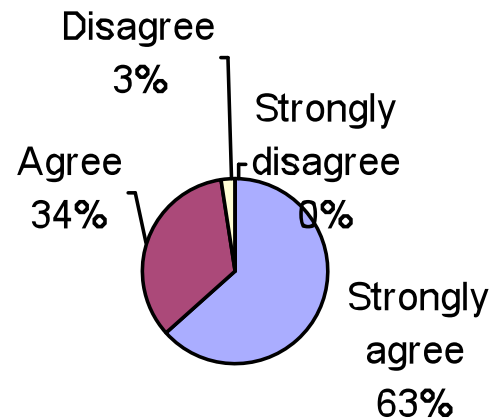
Enjoys & likes coming to school - 99% positive

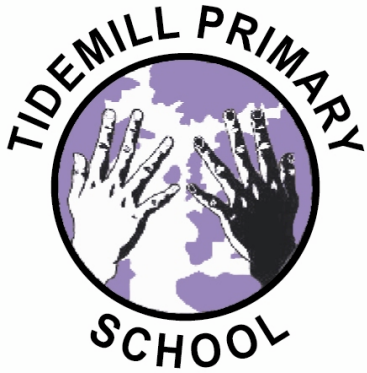

My child is making good progress



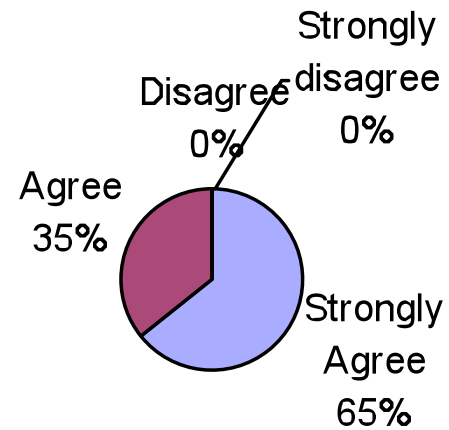
Is making good progress - 96% positive

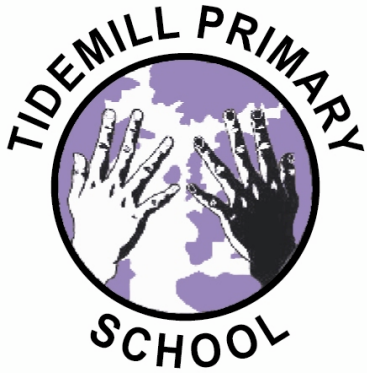

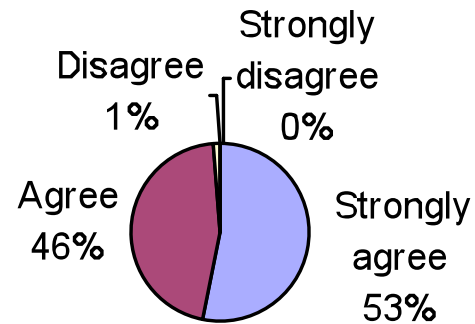
Feels safe & secure at school - 100% positive

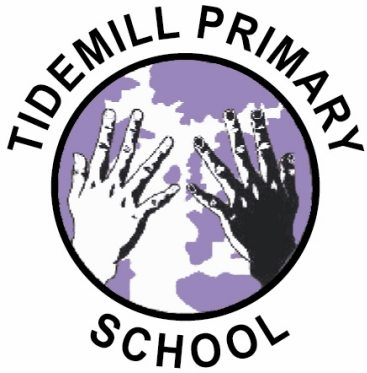

Likes the lessons and finds them challenging

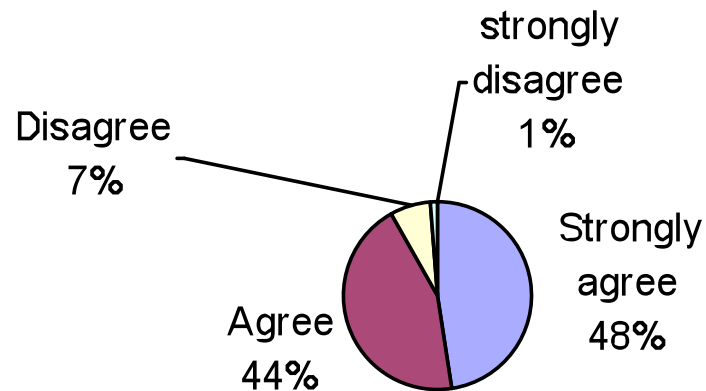


Likes the lessons & finds them challenging - 99%



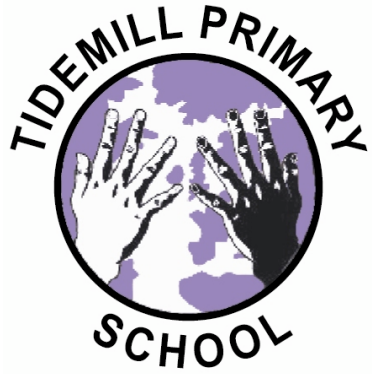

Doesn't feel bullied or picked on



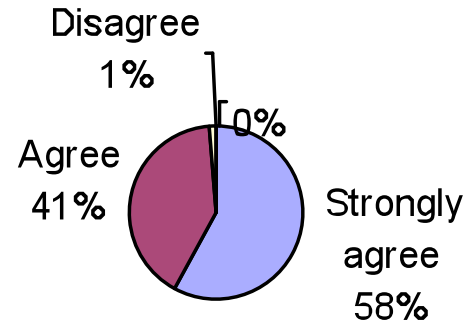

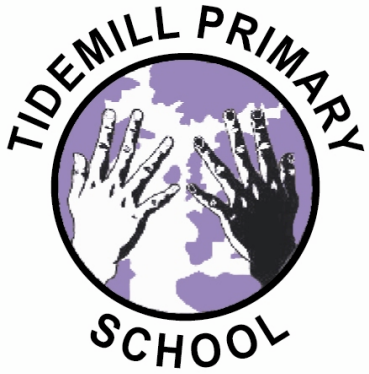

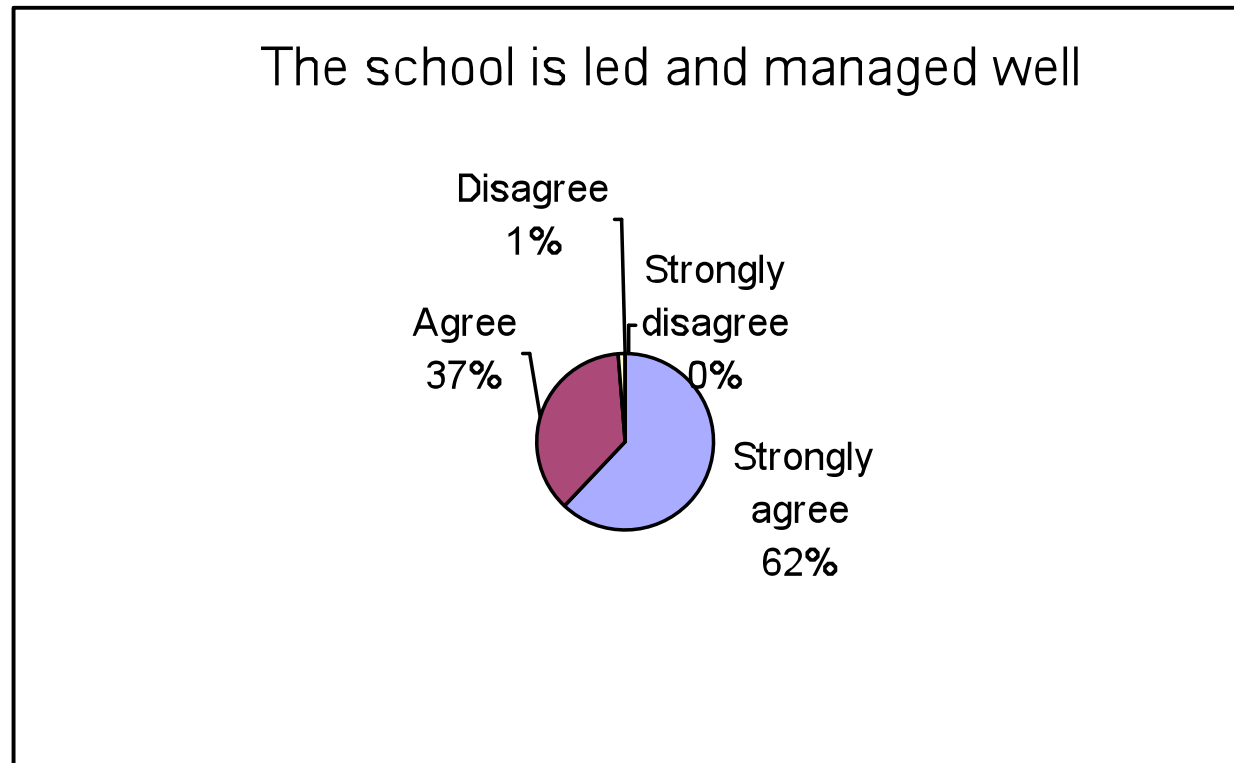

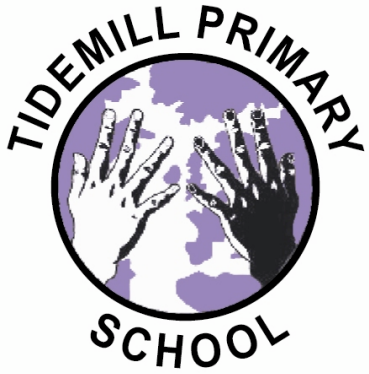

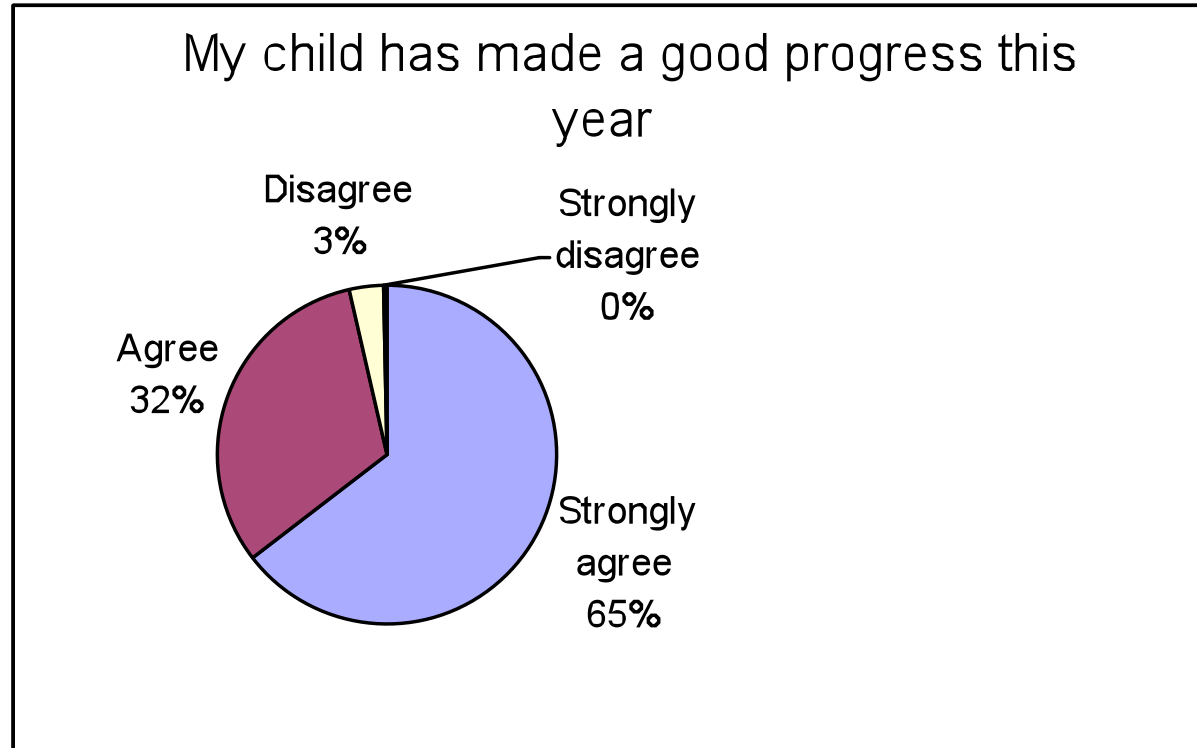

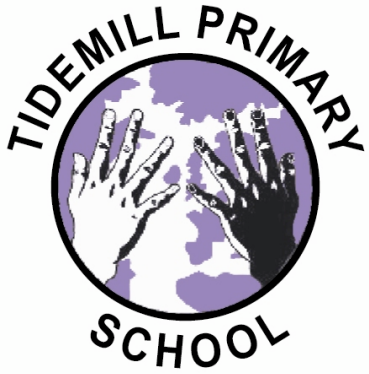

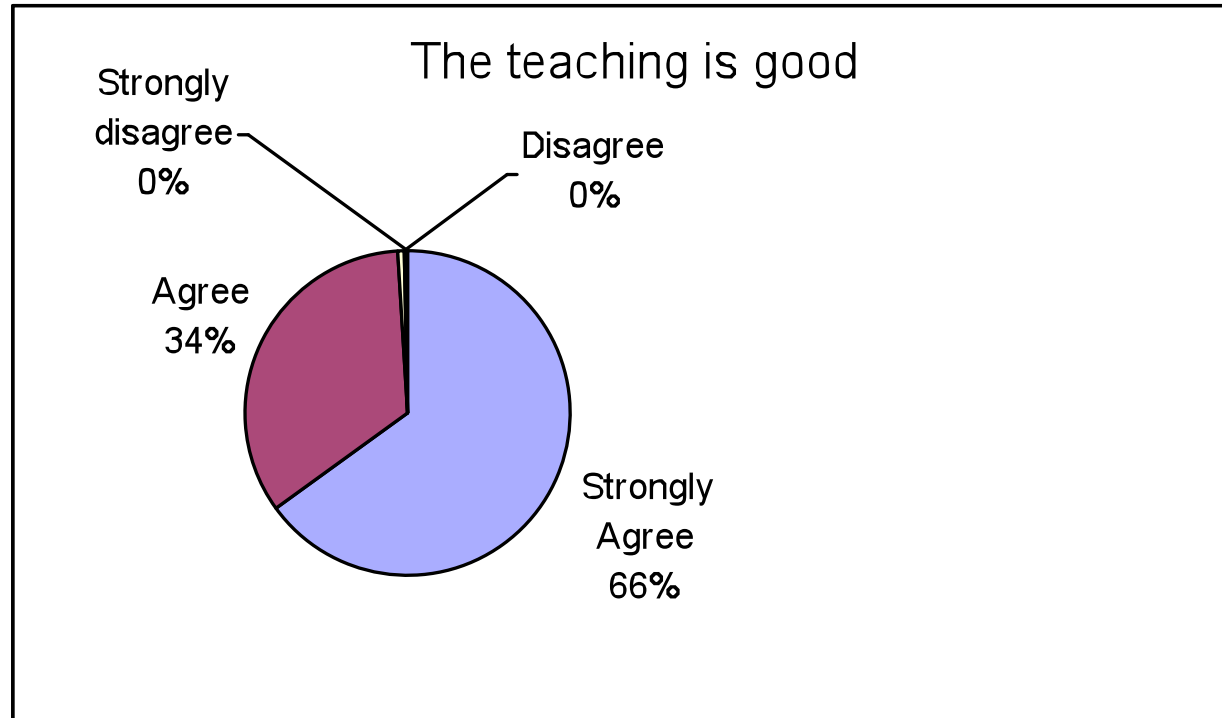

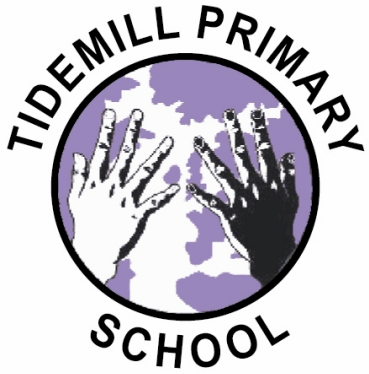

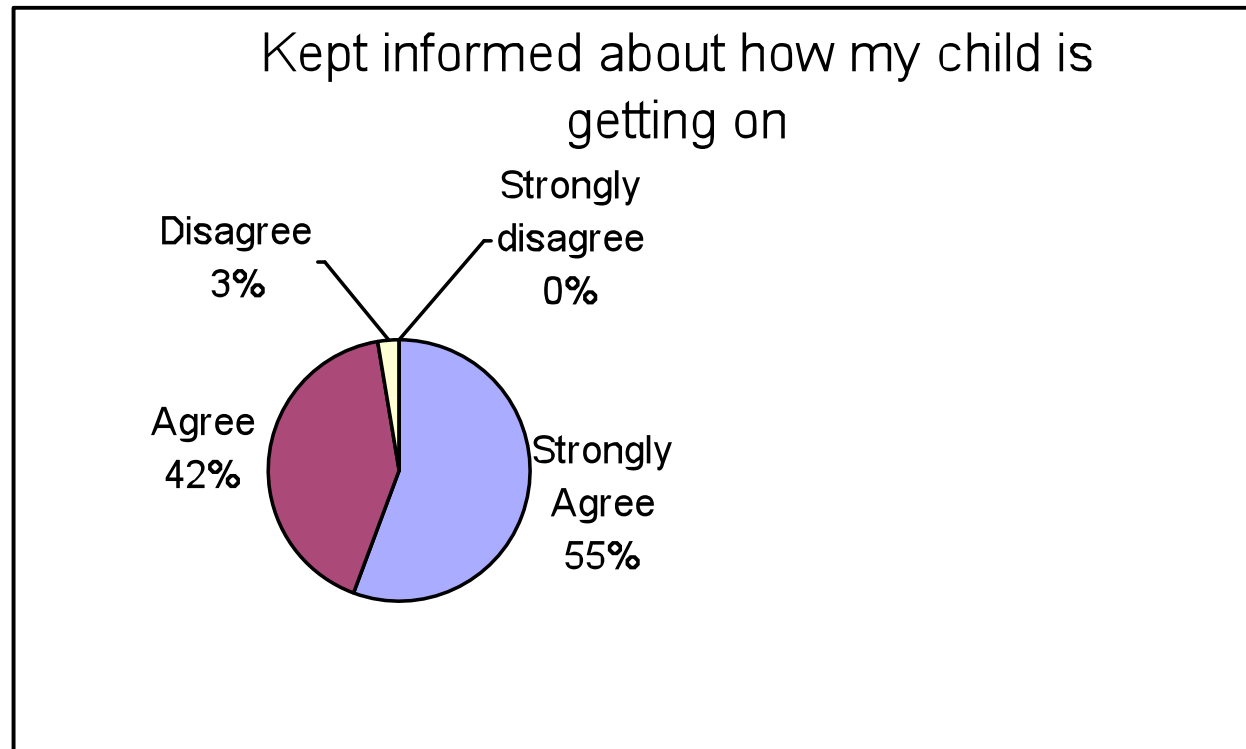

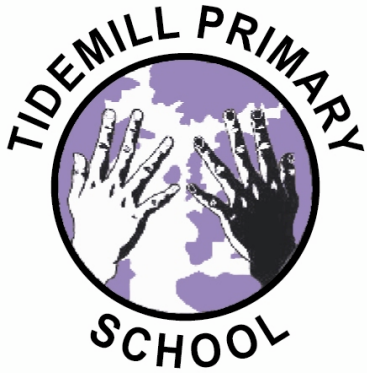

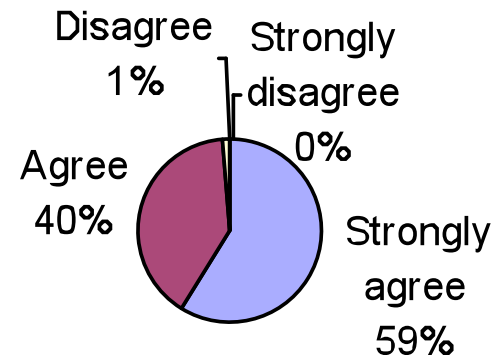

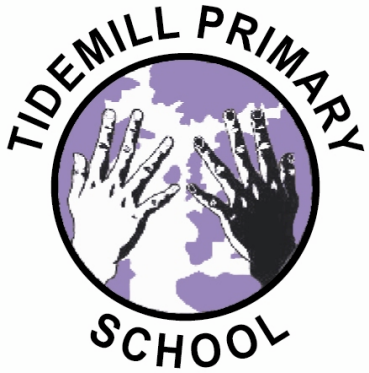

Comfortable about approaching with questions or a problem

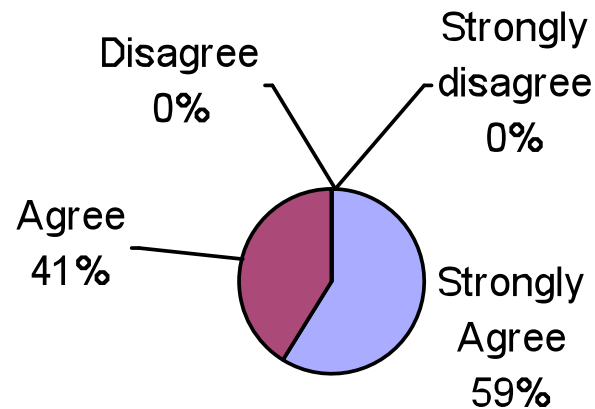


Comfortable about approaching with questions/problem - 99% positive

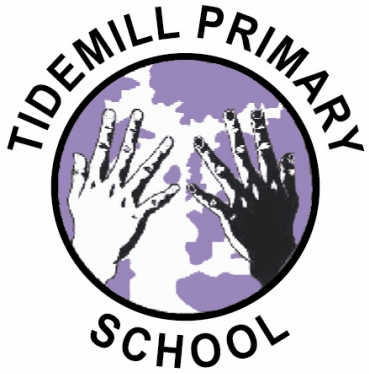

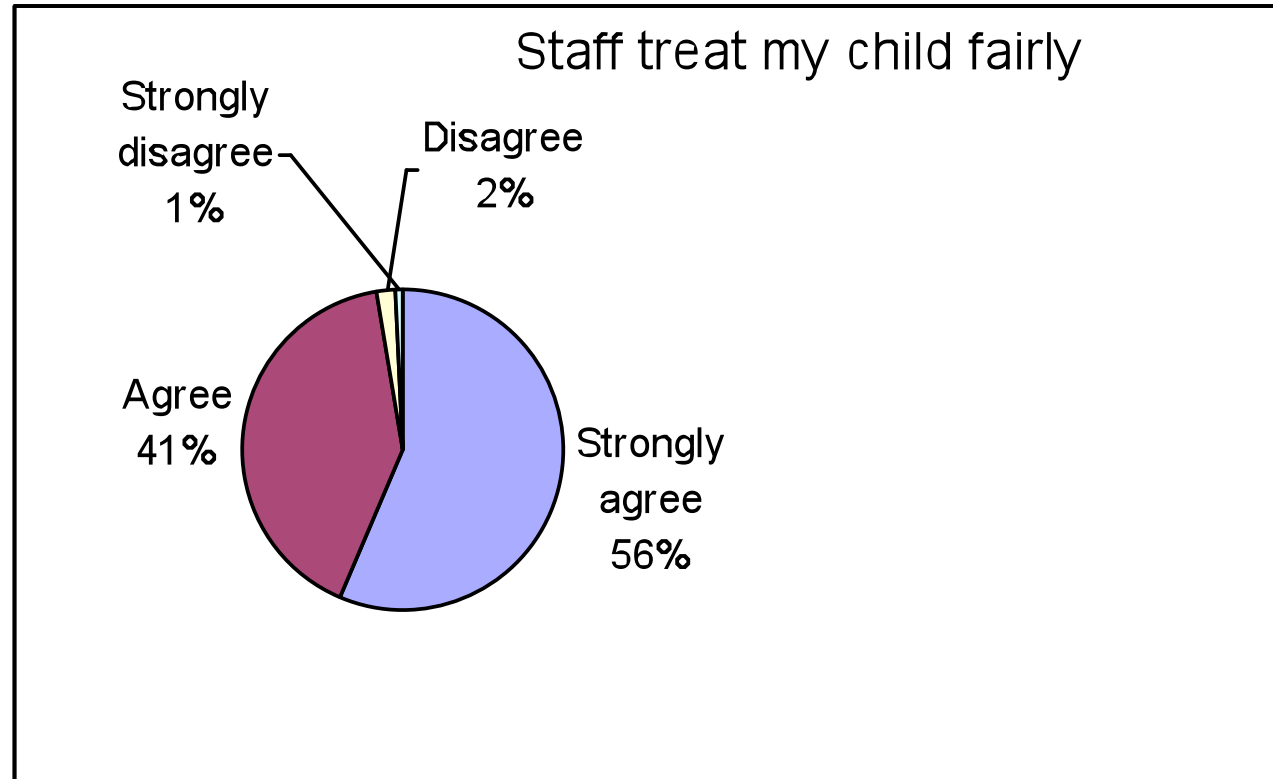
Staff expect a lot of my child & help them to achieve their best



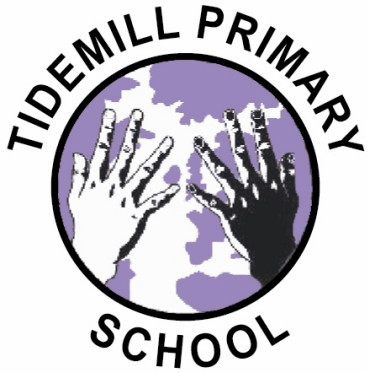
Staff expect a lot & help my child achieve -

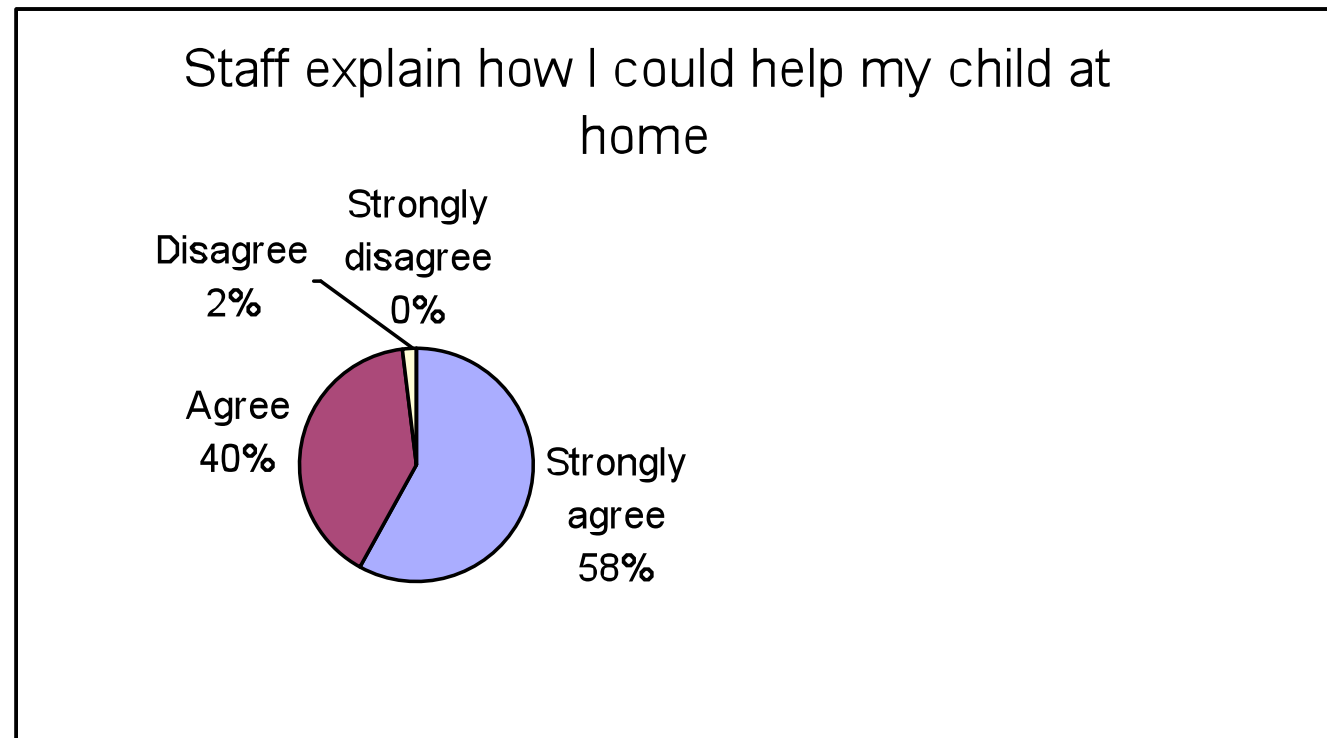

Staff treat my child fairly - 97% positive

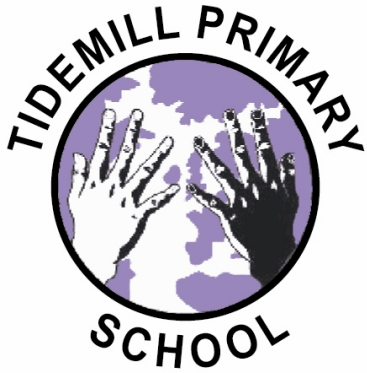

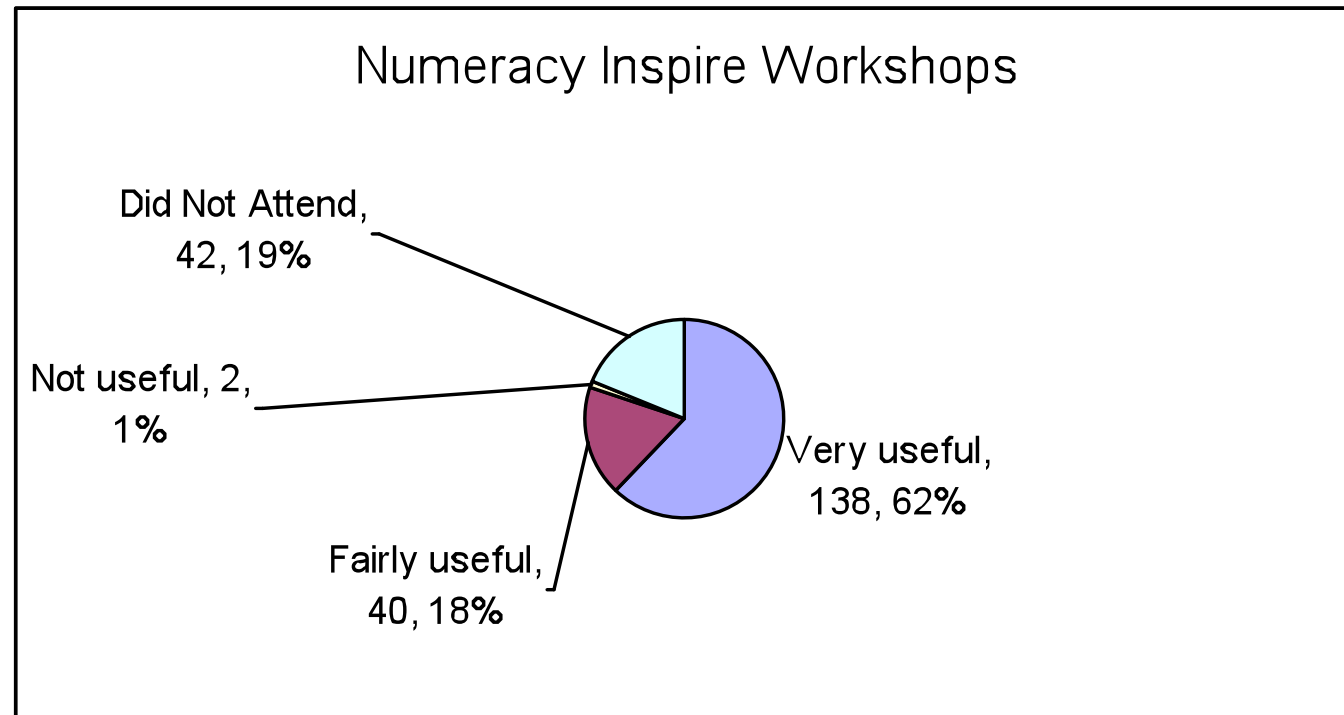


Staff explain how I can help my child at home -

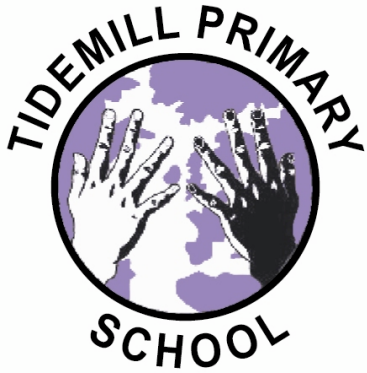

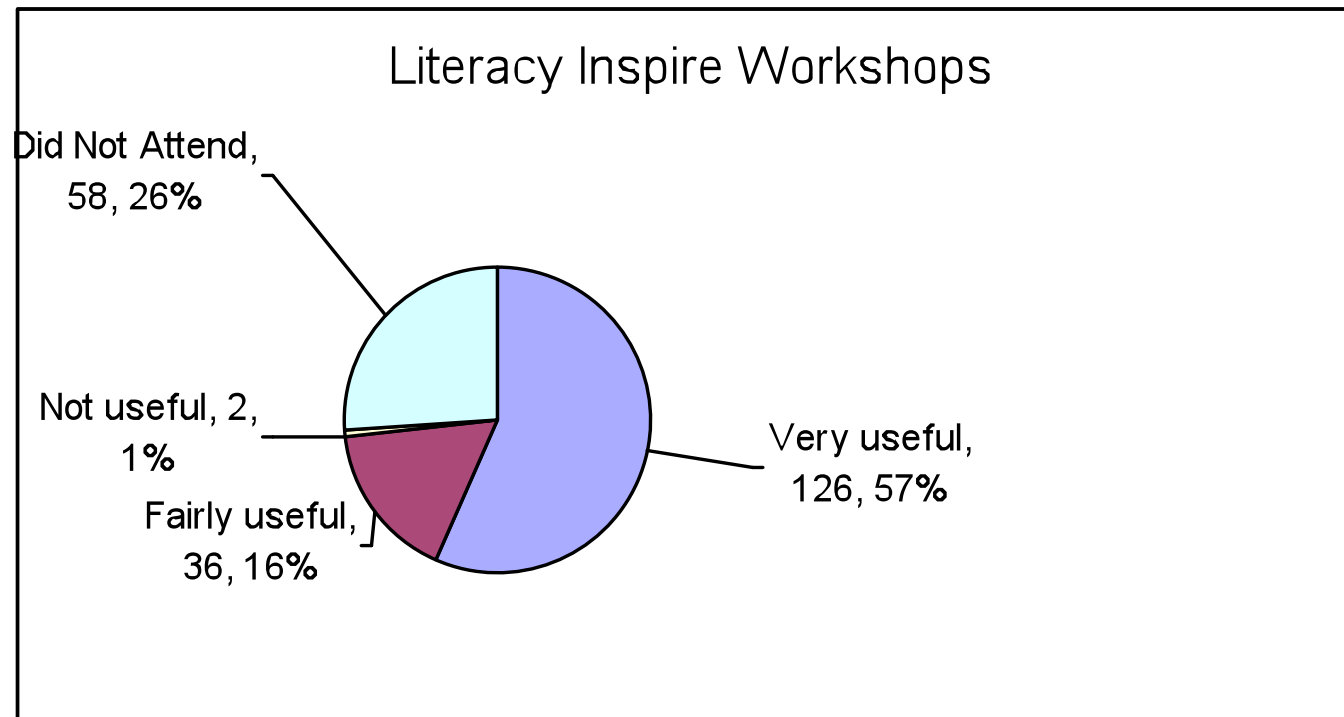

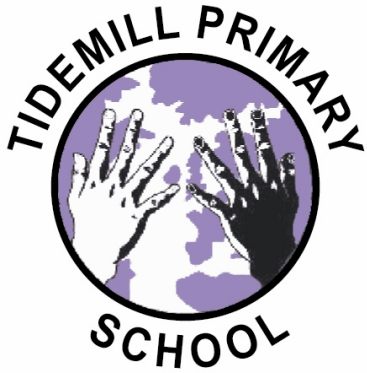
Numeracy - 231 parents answered, of which 80% found the workshop helpful



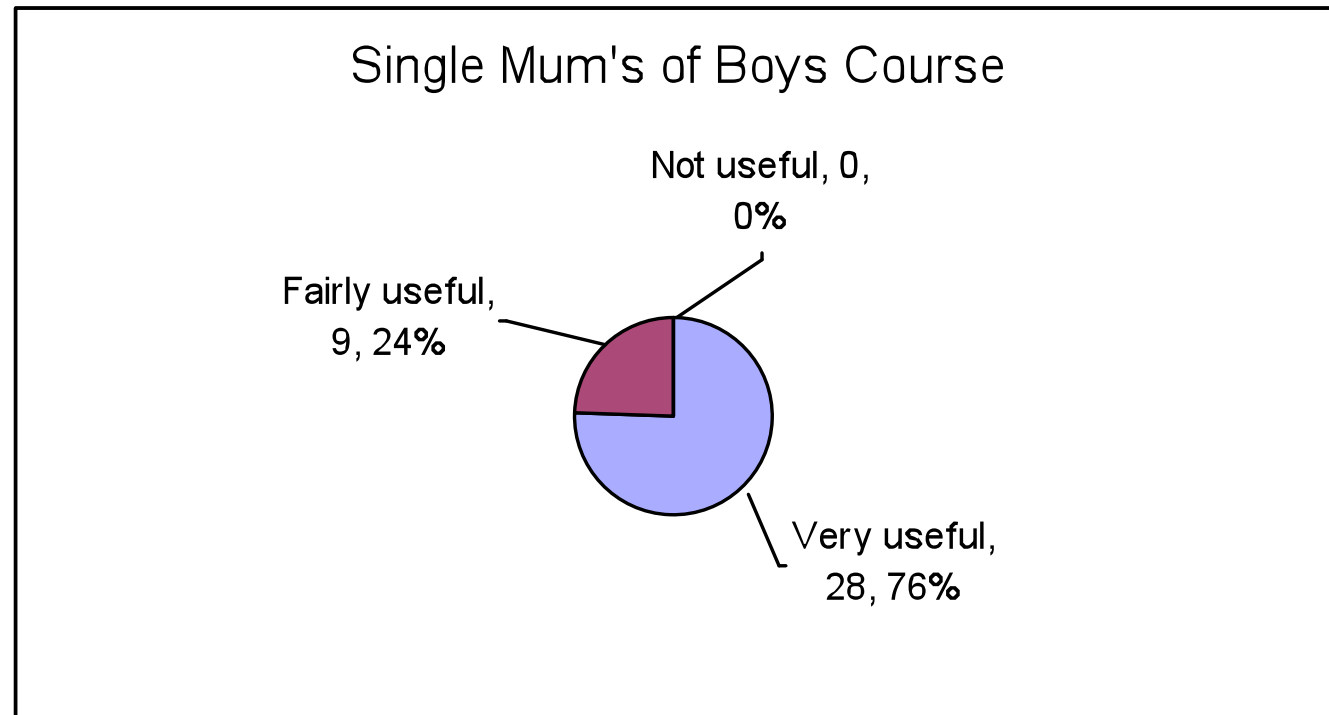

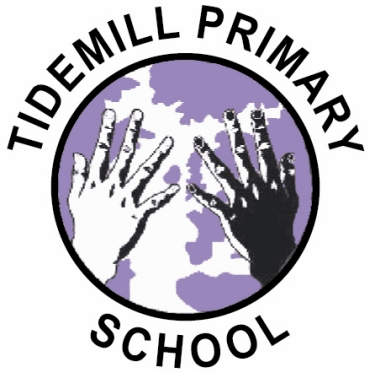
Literacy - 222 parents answered, of which 73% found the workshop useful



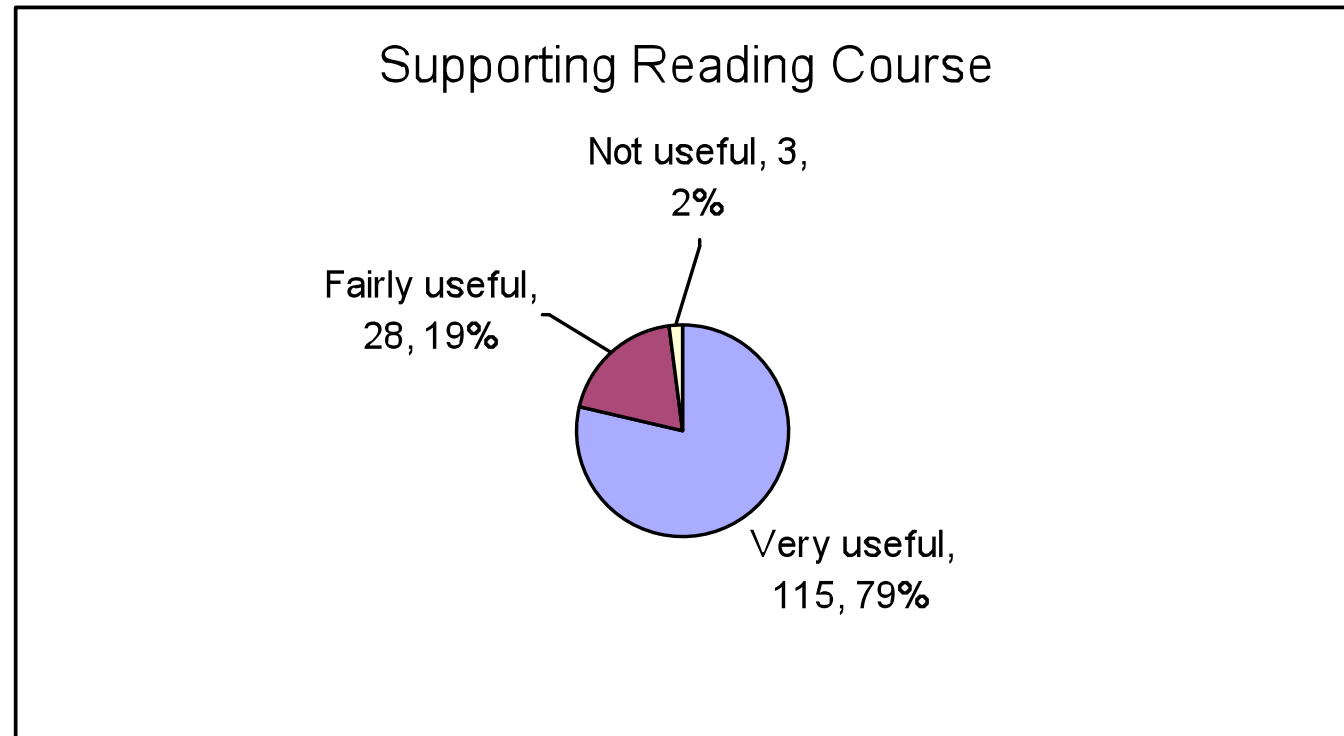
