



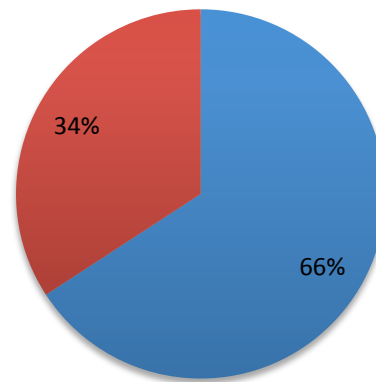

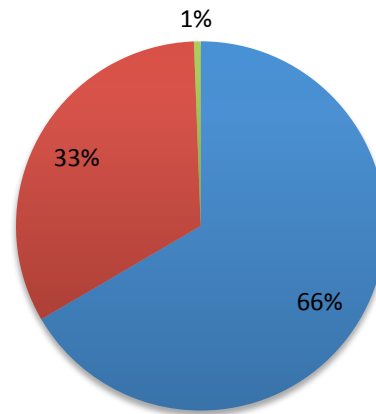

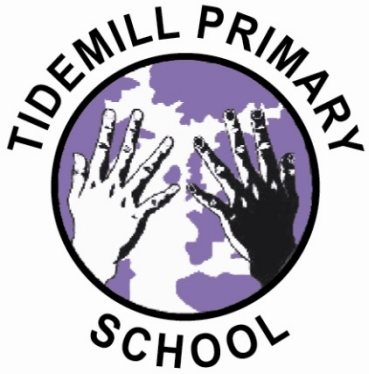
The teaching is good at Tidemill

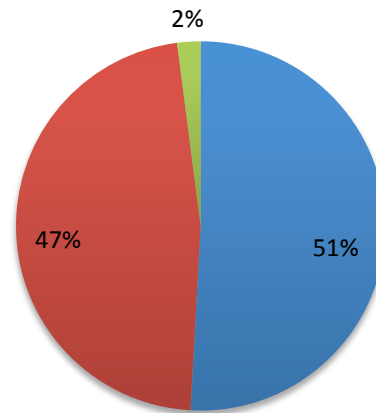

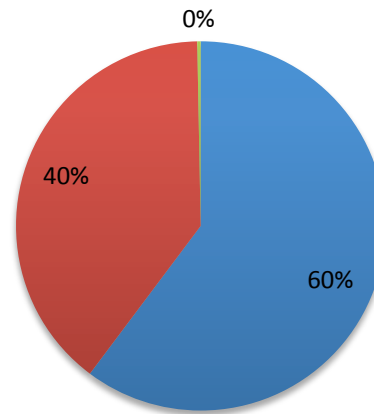

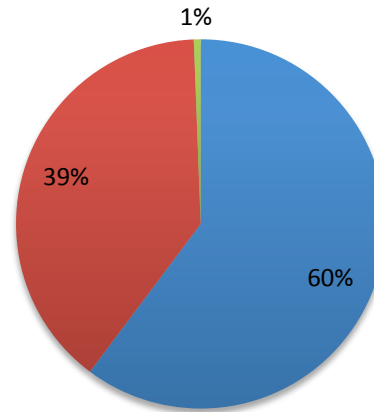

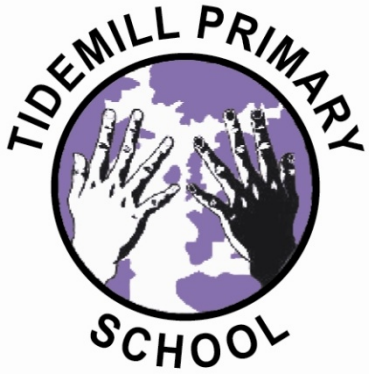

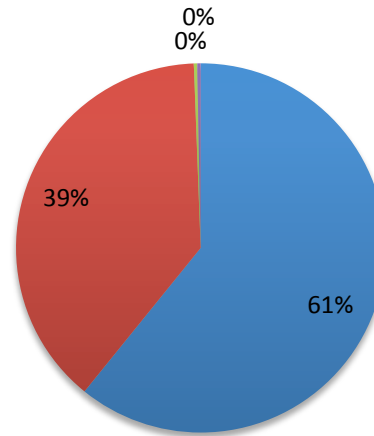

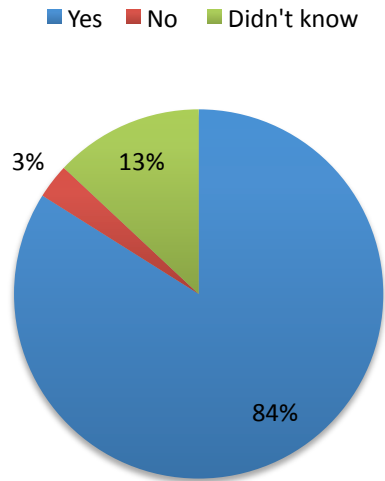

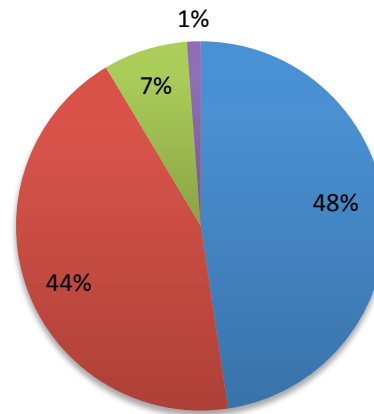

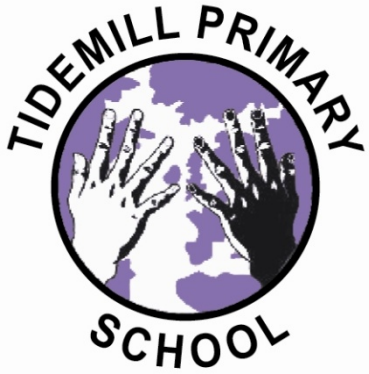
My child doesn't feel bullied or picked on

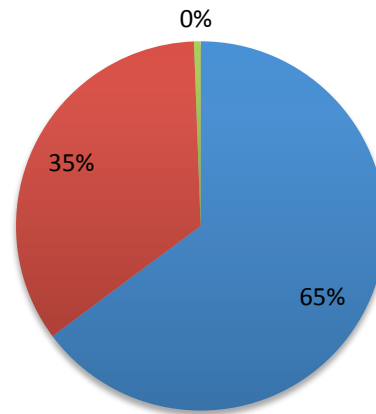

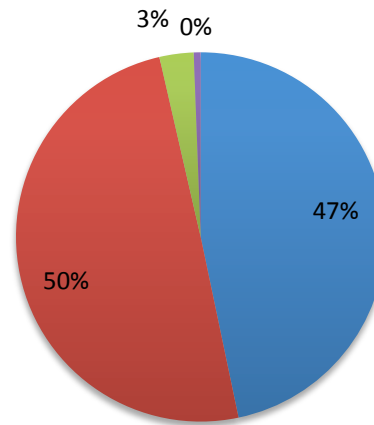

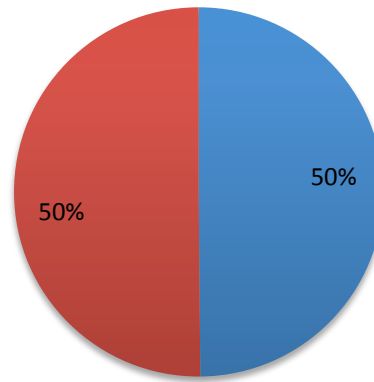

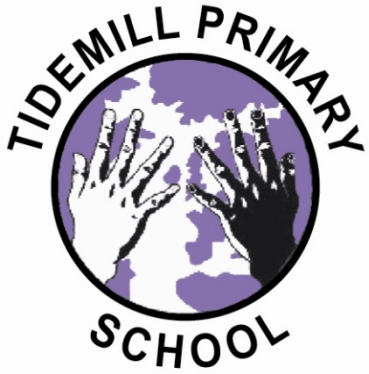
Tidemill promotes a healthy lifestyle

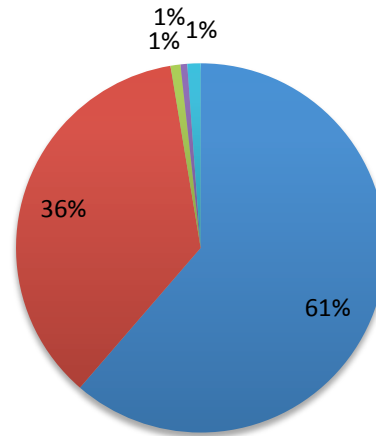

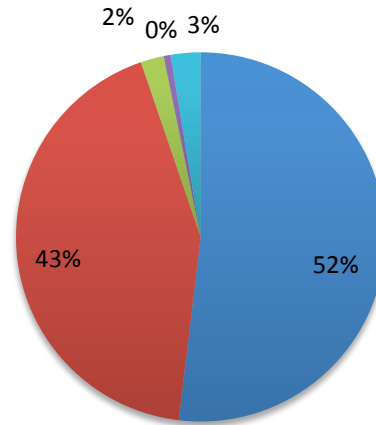

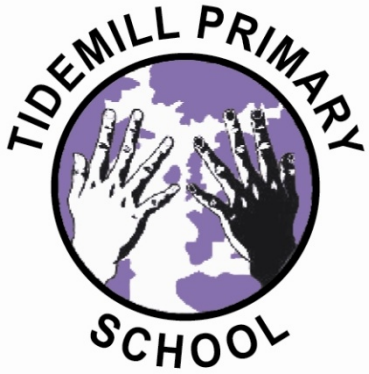

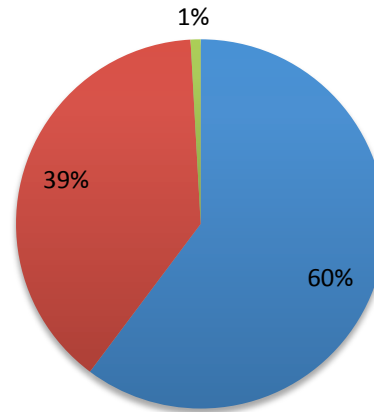

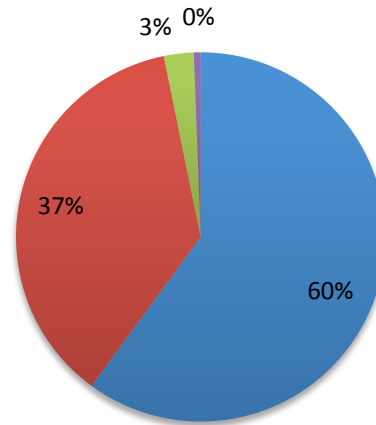

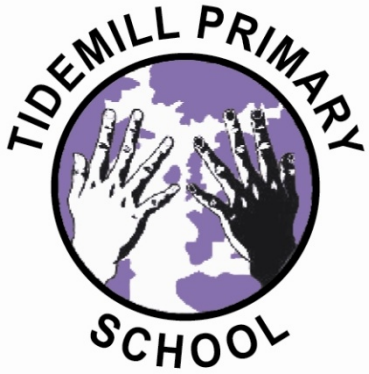
I am kept well informed about how my child is doing at school

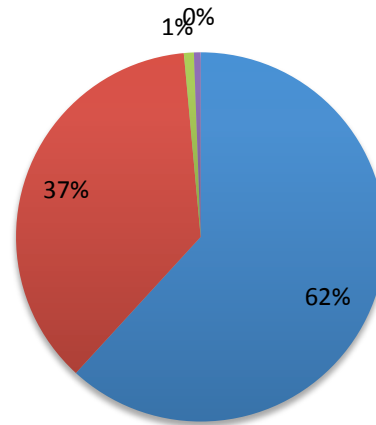

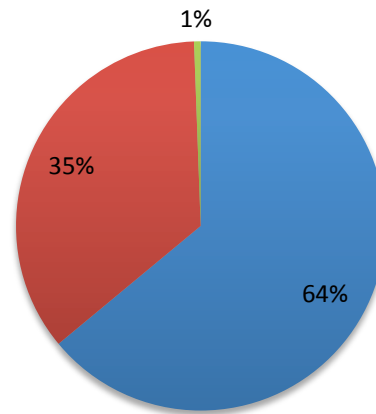

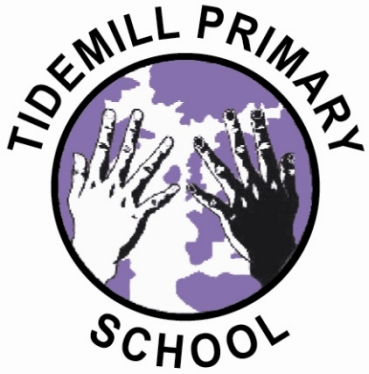
I feel comfortable about approaching the school if I have a problem or question

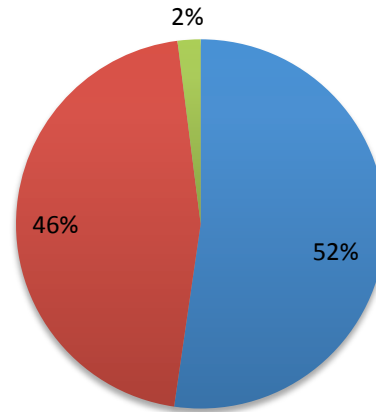

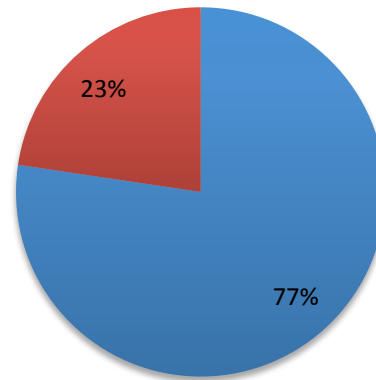
